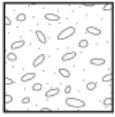
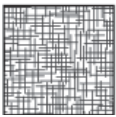
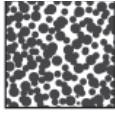
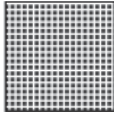


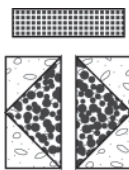
## King Size Directions - Back to Nature / Tonga Nature

Fabric 3 	Fabric 7 	Fabric 8 	Fabric 11 
Cut 6 - 3" x WOF sub-cut 80 ~ 3" squares	Cut 1 - 5½" x WOF sub-cut 6 ~ 5½" squares for geese base	Cut 1 - 5½" x WOF sub-cut 8 ~ 5½" squares for geese base	Cut 1 - 5½" x WOF sub-cut 6 ~ 5½" squares for geese base
			Cut 5 - 1½" x WOF from one strip sub-cut 4 ~ 1½" x 4½"

Make flying geese using the flying geese method (pg. 2 in general directions). Square each to 2 ½" x 4 ½". You will need an additional 32 red, 24 green and 24 blue (rose for Tonga Nature) geese for the King size quilt.

Form two more geese border strips that match the geese border strips on the top and bottom of the quilt as instructed in Geese Border: steps 1-3 on pg. 15.



Make four corner blocks by facing two red geese together, stitch and press. Add the 1 ½" x 4 ½" fabric 11 strips to one side of each newly formed squares. Add a corner square unit to each end of the geese border as shown in the diagram.

Stitch together two of the fabric 11 ~ 1 ½" x WOF strips end to end. Stitch to one side of the geese border. Repeat with other border. Press and attach to the quilt sides; proceed to *Bordering the Quilt* on the bottom of page 20 for finishing directions (for Tonga Nature Outer Borders on pg. 21). **Be sure to adjust the border lengths to fit the king size!**
